School Reopening's

- ATA has been in a continued dialogue with Alberta Education about what a return to school scenario would look like (possible scenarios)
- Safety of staff, students, parents and school communities comes first and foremost
- Government is also in dialogue with the other key stakeholders (ASBA, ASCA, CASS)
- We need to take our time, be deliberate and get this right

ADLC

- Changes for ADLC - funding has been reduced and will be eliminated altogether
- ADLC will likely be closing as of the end of next school year (June 2021) as it will not be feasible to run off a significantly reduced budget
- Dave Garbutt, in consultation with VV and ADLC teachers, is developing a plan for 130 staff transfers
- ADLC teachers are encouraged to call Member Services for advice moving forward (1-780-447-9400)

Professional Development

- Local 22 will be contributing \$70/teacher towards PD that is in conjunction with what the district provides (\$100/teacher) per year
- Teachers can apply to have \$300 every 2 years plus the cost of a sub IF required

- Deadlines for requests are September 30th and January 31st
- Decisions by the PD committee will be made within 7 business days
- This is for personal PD (does not have to align with goals of the division)
