- Bargaining 2020:



- Current Collective Agreement had an end date of 2020.
- Bargaining is 2-tier:
 - Provincial matters were settled with mediator's report and teachers voted in June
 - Local matters follow provincial settlement
- Currently looking at improvements to collective agreement on matters on local issues
- Survey data is being collected and will be compiled into an opening proposal for negotiations to begin at our local level
- A Bargaining Unit General Meeting (BUGM) will be held for Pembina Hills teachers to view, provide feedback, and vote on opening proposal.
