Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Checks

- Effective September 1, 2022, Bill 85 amended the Education Act by adding Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Checks
- Bill 85 applies to those whose employment requires a certificate of qualification as a teacher, a leadership certificate or a superintendent leadership certificate.
- CRC (criminal record checks) must be obtained from a police detachment of your home location.
- Pembina Hills is collecting CRC from groups of individuals based on last name (you will receive an email from Human Resources when it your time to proceed with obtaining one).
