

### Rebuilding the Special Emergency Fund (SEF)

- ATA fee will remain the same (annual fee will be reduced by October to \$1303.50 for October 2025 since no fees were collected that month), but this repayment will be separate, so it doesn't stay as part of our fees.
- Goal to repay it at \$40/month to be repaid within 16 mos. starting in February.
- This also means that people who had benefits paid out over the strike will be responsible for paying it back, and not new teachers in the following years.
- The SEF was also used for communications expenses and legal fees.
- A review committee will be implemented to look into the last two bargaining rounds (2020 and 2024) to verify that they were fair and that the CTBC bargained fairly on behalf of teachers.
