

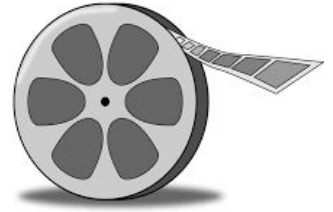

Changes to Professional Development (PD) Funding

- There has been an increase in the money available for PD and the application deadline for the first round is Sept. 30th.
- For in province professional development, a maximum of \$1,500 is available for all costs associated with registration, accommodations, travel, and additional expenses (receipts required), as well as the cost of a sub for up to a maximum of 3 days.
- A maximum of four \$2,500 grants for out of province PD with the above described parameters.
- A maximum of \$1,500 for tuition costs is available.
- PD Funds Approval Meeting will be held on Oct. 6th.
